III. Ways we should thank God today.

- A. Ephesians 5:3-4. Thanks instead of...
  - 1. Many things believers should not be talking about.
  - 2. Thanks is what we should be talking about.
- B. Ephesians 5:19-20. Thankful to God.
  - 1. The Spirit and praise help lead us to thanks. Ephesians 5:19.
  - 2. Thankfulness should just be part of our Christian behavior.
- C. Philippians 4:6-7. Thankfulness in prayer.
  - 1. Give thanks even while making requests.
  - 2. Thanksgiving helps to bring peace!
- D. Colossians 1:3-5, 12. Thankful for our hope.
  - 1. The hope laid up in heaven.
  - 2. Partakers of the inheritance.
- E. Colossians 2:7. Thankfulness helps our faith abound.
- F. Colossians 3:15. Thankfulness is a command, not an option.
- G. Colossians 3:17. Be thankful in all we do.
- H. Colossians 4:2. Thanksgiving should be a constant part of our prayers.
- I. I Timothy 2:1-2. Thanks of first importance.
  - 1. Thankfulness for all men.
  - 2. Thankfulness for rulers.
- J. I Timothy 4:1-5. Thanksgiving for food.
  - 1. God created food to be received with thanksgiving.
  - 2. Part of the doctrine of demons is lack of thankfulness!

IV. Conclusion. Thankfulness is something that is of first importance to God, yet it is something each and every one of us struggles with. We need to remember all God has done for us, and work at making thankfulness part of our everyday lives.
